Brief Description of Climbing Coach Position

The primary responsibility of each climbing coach will be to teach a variety of different types of classes and individuals. Every coach will work symbiotically with other climbing coaches and the Head Coach to help build a robust climbing program for the facility.

General Responsibilities and Duties

The climbing coach will work on a part-time basis, dependant on class enrollment, and will help develop programs, instruct, track students, and meet goals set for the climbing programs.

Specific Time Commitments

The position of a climbing coach is part-time and people filling this role can expect to work a minimum of 10 hours per week and up to as many hours as are available. The time worked is comprised of planning and administrative time and actual instruction. If a coach desires and is so suited, s/he may also work additional hours in other areas of the facility.

Compensation Package

While there is a stated pay scale range for this position, the specific compensation package will be commensurate with the experience of the hired individual.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty promptly and competently. Ideally, a candidate would have past experience with working with youth and/or adults in an instructional capacity.

Experience as a climbing coach is a plus. Candidate must have experience working with a team.

Attributes of a successful candidate will include excellent customer service capabilities, ability to problem-solve, uncompromised integrity and strong ethics, articulate and effective communication skills on all levels, dependability, responsibility, and accountability. The candidate should also reside in or near Boulder, CO.
