



Spin Instructor Positions Available

Brief Description of Spin Instructor Position

The primary responsibility of each spin instructor will be to teach classes that are comprised of individuals with varying skill levels. Every instructor will work symbiotically with other spin instructors and the Spin Director to help build a robust spin program for the facility.

General Responsibilities and Duties

The spin instructor will work on a part-time basis and will help develop programs, instruct, track class participation and interest, and meet goals set for the spin program.

Specific Time Commitments

The position of a spin instructor is part-time and people filling this role can expect to teach a minimum of 1 to 2 classes per week with potential to teach more. The time worked is comprised of planning and administrative time and actual instruction. Should an individual be interested in and qualified for other positions within the facility as well, s/he is more than welcome to also work additional hours in those areas.

Compensation Package

The stated pay scale range for this position is competitive, and the specific compensation package will be commensurate with the experience of the hired individual.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty promptly and competently. Ideally, a candidate would have past experience as a spin instructor. All instructors must have some form of teacher certification. Experience as an instructor of a variety of classes is a plus.

Attributes of a successful candidate will include excellent customer service capabilities, ability to accommodate different skill levels in one class, uncompromised integrity and strong ethics, articulate and effective communication skills on all levels, dependability, responsibility, and accountability. The candidate should also reside in or near Boulder, CO.
